



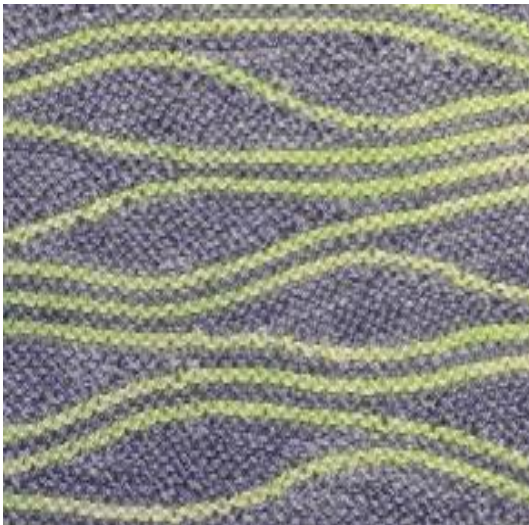

Swing-Knitting™ Taster Class “Lismeverruckt“

Swing-Knitting™

is a unique technique of short row knitting that uses areas of short rows to create a harmonious pattern.



In the Taster Class you'll learn:

- the vocabulary Swing-Knitting™ uses to describe its specific elements
- the basic rules of Swing-Knitting™
- making the double stitch as an easy way of turning without getting a hole
- making a provisional cast-on by crocheting around the knitting needle
- using safety pins as a means of taking notes within your knitting
- knitting light stanzas, dark stanzas and pauses

You'll get a printed tutorial with detailed explanations how to finish your first piece of Swing-Knitting™ at home. This includes a detailed pattern instruction for the Lismeverruckt shawl.



The class lasts for approx. 3 hours.

You will get a detailed printed tutorial and the safety pins that you'll need.

What you'll need for the class:

- Siidegarte Siide-Liind in 2 colors: 180 g in color 1, 120 g in color 2
- 3.5 mm circular knitting needles or your size to reach the gauge 19 stitches/38 rows for 10x10 cm in garter stitch
- Smooth waste yarn for the provisional cast-on
- Crochet hook 3.5 mm
